

Bridgend Walk No 3

(Brewery Lane Car Park)
Approx 45 - 60 minutes to walk.

Level of walk **1**

Easy access - suitable for pushchairs and wheelchairs.

From the Brewery Lane car park at the rugby club.



Leave the car park at the coach park end and follow the footpath and cycle track signs.



When you corner of the road and it turns right, cross the road keeping the childrens park on your left.



Continue past Bookers and garages stay on the footpath until you see the cycle barriers on the opposite side of the road. Follow the cycle trail then bear right, under the bridge, staying on the footpath.



Look out for the footbridge on your right and turn right over the river. When you reach the other side of the Bridge turn left staying on the path.



Go through the gate at the end of the residential street and continue on the cycle trail.



Continue alongside the river until you reach the footbridge over the river, this is the mid point of the walk. Retrace your steps.



Follow the cycle path signs with the river on the left.



Keep the river on your left and continue to follow the path.



Continue to follow the cycle track.



Bear right beside the river.



Walk back over the bridge and under the railway line.



Continue in front of the business units and return to the Brewery lane car park.
